PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The MCI FAAT/SAT Project represents a new generation of satellite to ground communications for the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The project consists of over 350 sites in every U.S. state except Alaska, as well as additional sites located in U.S. possessions as well as offshore in the Gulf of Mexico.



The Construction Management responsibilities for this project were awarded to ECI on the basis of our previous high level of performance in providing engineering and surveying services to MCI. These services being provided by ECI are a critical element of MCI's Project Plan to successfully execute design and construction over a four (4) year duration. At peak, ECI employed fifteen (15) Field Engineers to provide construction interface, materials coordination and quality control, as well as monitor schedule adherence.

Specific service provided by ECI for site design included permitting, property surveys, horizon profiles, frequency interference studies and construction drawings.
